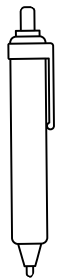


Why is it important to recycle your writing instruments?

What can be recycled through the Writing Instruments Recycling Program?

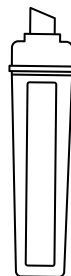

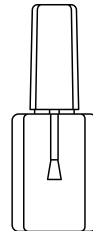
