NATURE'S ORGANICS BOTTLE CHANDELIER

Shine a new light on empty bottles with this lighting project!

MATERIALS

- 12-15 empty bottles
- Christmas lights

TOOLS

- electric drill
- 1/8" drill bit
- 12-15 small zip ties
- 3 large zip ties
- permanent marker
- extension cord



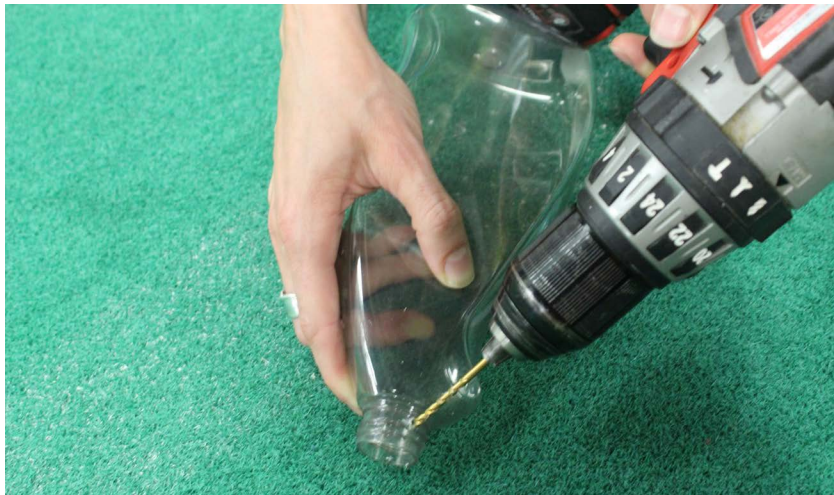


START!

STEP 1 Begin with clean, empty bottles. Mark 2 holes with your permanent marker on the neck of each bottle. The markings should be opposite sides of each other.

STEP 2

With the drill and the 1/8" drill bit, drill where you've marked your holes.



STEP 3

Start at one end of the Christmas light strand, and feed lights through the neck of the bottle. Each bottle fits 8-10 bulbs and have two light strand cords coming out of the bottle opening.



STEP 4

Secure the lights in place by looping a zip tie through the two drilled holes. The two light strand ends will fall on either side of the zip tie. Cut off the excess zip tie tip.



STEP 5

When you've used all of your bottles and lights, take the cording in between each bottle and wrap into a bundle. Zip tie the bundle together. The more you tighten the zip tie, the more the bottle will take shape into a light fixture. Depending on the amount of bulk, you may need to separate the fixture into two sides and then combine them.
