



Schneiders® Lunchmate® Collection Craze 2020 Detailed Rules

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT ENHANCE YOUR ABILITY TO PARTICIPATE OR WIN. THIS CONTEST IS INTENDED FOR ENTRY IN CANADA AND WILL BE GOVERNED BY CANADIAN LAW. DO NOT ENTER IF YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE AND LOCATED IN CANADA AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** OPEN ONLY TO LEGAL RESIDENTS OF ALL PROVINCES AND TERRITORIES OF CANADA WITH THE EXCEPTION OF QUEBEC WHO HAVE ATTAINED THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN THEIR PROVINCE OR TERRITORY OF RESIDENCE AS OF DATE OF ENTRY. Employees, officers and directors of TerraCycle Canada ULC. ("Sponsor"), their respective parents, subsidiaries, and affiliated companies, promotional partners and advertising and Contest agencies, representatives, agents, web masters/suppliers (and their dependents, immediate family members [spouse, parents, children, siblings] and persons with whom they are domiciled, whether or not related) are not eligible to participate. By participating, entrants agree to these Official Rules, the decisions of the judges regarding Entry judging, and the decisions of the Sponsor and/or its independent judging agency which are final and binding in all respects. 1a. **SPECIFIC ELIGIBILITY:** Schneiders® Lunchmate® Collection Craze ("Contest") is open to all active participants ("Participants") in the Schneiders® Lunchmate® Recycling Program ("Participating Program") who match the eligibility requirements outlined above. Sign up to become a TerraCycle collection location for free at www.terracecycle.ca. Recycling program locations can "opt out" of the Contest by contacting TerraCycle customer support at customersupport@terracecycle.ca.

2. **CONTESTAL PERIOD:** The Contest will run from October 15th, 2020 at 6 a.m. PST and ends December 15th, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. PST ("Contest Period").

3. **TO ENTER:** Participants meeting the conditions set forth in paragraph number 1a above are automatically enrolled in the Contest.

3a. **FOR SCHOOLS:** The goal of the Contest is for the Schools within the Participating Program to earn the most Credits ("Credits"). Credits are earned by sending used Lunchmate packaging (each comprised of "Units", as defined herein) into TerraCycle through the Participating Recycling Program. One (1) Unit is defined as ten (10) grams of used post-consumer Lunchmate packaging. Each Unit will earn one (1) Credit. Units can be sent through the Schools TerraCycle account on the Sponsor Website. Contest winners will be determined by the total number of Credits earned for their Schools within Contest Period. All Units must be received and checked into the TerraCycle system as visible on the School's account profile on www.terracecycle.com by December 15th, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. PST. Additionally, all schools that send in a photo will be entered into a sweepstakes drawing to win 50,000 TerraCycle bonus points. Each school can only submit one



photo, and must comply with the following criteria to qualify: the photograph must show the school's recycling collection bin, receptacles and/or stations.

3b. FOR INDIVIDUALS: Participating Program locations meeting the above described conditions, and not having the organization type of a School, are automatically enrolled in the Contest. The goal of the Contest for these Participants is to send in a qualifying shipment of accepted packaging waste through the Participating Program during the Contest Period.

4. DETERMINATION OF WINNERS: All Schools in the Participating Program will have their Credits tallied for the Contest. The top four (4) Schools that receive the most Credits will be Winners ("Winners"). For the individual shipments, five (5) Participants will be chosen at random to be deemed the Winners. For the photo contest, one qualified entry from a School and one qualifying entry from a non-School participant will be chosen at random to be deemed the Winners.

5. TIE BREAKERS: Contest determinations are in the sole and absolute discretion of the Sponsor, and such decisions are not subject to further review or appeal by the Schools.

6. PRIZES:

Each School Winner in the Collection Contest will receive 50,000 TerraCycle points.

Five Non-School Participants will be chosen at random to receive a \$100 CAD gift card.

One randomly selected school from our photo sweepstakes drawing will receive 50,000 TerraCycle bonus points. One randomly selected Non-School Participant from our photo sweepstakes will receive a \$500 CAD gift card.

Each TerraCycle point can be redeemed for \$.01 per point per point to the non-profit organization of their choice. The total ARV of all prizes is \$3,500 CAD.

7.
