

# FOOD POUCH DUCT TAPE TOTE

This tote-ally cool tote will let you carry your upcycled style wherever you go!

### **MATERIALS**

- 12 food pouches
- duct tape
- clear tape

#### **TOOLS**

- scissors
- ruler





## **Instructions:**

**STEP 1** Cut off the tops of your food pouches. Clean the inside with soap and water.

#### STEP 2

Lay out one side of the tote so you have three pouches wide by two pouches tall. Overlap each pouch by about ½ cm and tape in place with clear tape. This will be the first side of your bag.




#### STEP 3

Repeat this step for the rest of your pouches creating the other side of your bag.

**Pro Tip:** You can recycle any food pouch scraps through TerraCycle's food pouch Collections program.



Tape a piece of duct tape across the top of each panel.



Create the handle by cutting a piece of duct tape that is 40 cm long and folding it in half lengthwise. Repeat for a second handle.



Tape the handle onto the top of your bag about 5 cm in from the side and an inch from the top. Repeat for the other side.



Place the front and back panels on top of each other. Then tape around the sides and bottom of the bag with duct tape.



#### STEP 8

Finish your bag by taping down the front and continuing the duct tape up the back of the bag securing the handles in place. Repeat for both handles. Your bag is ready to use!
