



COLGATE® BRUSHES UP PLAYTIME WITH THE FIRST UK PLAYGROUND MADE OF RECYCLED ORAL CARE PRODUCTS



LONDON, 27.09.19: Today Colgate®, alongside recycling partner TerraCycle®, unveils at Cranford Park Primary School in Yateley, Hampshire, the launch of the first playground in the UK made from recycled oral care products.

The playground was made using lumber created with over 30,000 recycled oral care products including toothbrushes, tubes, caps, electric toothbrush heads and toothbrush and toothpaste packaging, and is available for the children to enjoy and use from today. It consists of two slides, a bridge and a tunnel.

The playground made of recycled oral care products was awarded to Cranford Park following a nationwide competition run in association with ASDA, which saw communities vote for the school they would most like to win this coveted prize. The playground is a welcome addition to the school, as for the past year, they have not had a dedicated climbing area where the children could play.

Adding some colour into playtime, Colgate® hopes the playground will be a reminder to the children and their parents about the simple steps we can all take to protect the environment, and how household items such as toothbrushes and toothpastes, can be given a second life after we no longer need them.

Colgate® partnered with TerraCycle® in 2018 to launch the Colgate® Oral Care Recycling Programme, a nationwide recycling solution to ensure that oral care waste is recycled.

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Notes to Editors

In November 2018, TerraCycle® and Colgate® announced a free nationwide recycling solution for oral care products and packaging in the UK: The Colgate® Oral Care Recycling Programme. This programme enables people to recycle any brand of toothbrush, toothpaste tubes and caps, toothbrush outer packaging, electric and battery toothbrush heads and toothpaste cartons for free whilst raising funds for the school, charity or non-profit of the sender's choice.

How the Colgate® Oral Care Recycling Programme works:



There are two different ways to participate in the Colgate® Oral Care Recycling Programme:

1. Drop off your oral care products at your nearest public access drop-off location (there are over 900 in place across the UK) by finding your participating location on the map on The Colgate® Oral Care Recycling Programme page

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2. Set up your public drop-off location. If there are no public drop-off locations near you, you can set up your own.

If you do not have a TerraCycle® account yet, there are three steps you will need to complete to register for the Colgate® Oral Care Recycling Programme.

- 1. You must create an account at www.terracycle.co.uk by clicking on the sign-up button and filling out the form.
- 2. Then click "join programme for free" on The Colgate® Oral Care Recycling Programme page.
- 3. Fill out the public access drop-off location form.

Then when the collector wants to post a shipment, they download a free UPS label from their account, attach it to the shipment and then simply order a free pick-up via UPS by calling 03457 877 or book a collection online. UPS will then collect from their location. Or the parcels can also be dropped off at the nearest UPS drop-off point.

For each shipment, over 2 kilos for the Colgate® Oral Care Recycling Programme, the sender receives TerraCycle® points. 100 points is earned per kilo. 100 TerraCycle® points represents £1. The points can then be redeemed to the school, charity or non-profit of the sender's choice.

Once received by TerraCycle®, the oral care products and packaging are sorted and separated by material composition. The separated items are then cleaned, shredded, and the recycled pellet material is used by manufacturers to make products such as benches and fence posts rather than using new virgin plastics.
