SPONTEX® LAUNCHES UK RECYCLING SOLUTION FOR DISPOSABLE GLOVES

Partnership with TerraCycle enables consumers nationwide to recycle vinyl, latex, nitrile and polyethylene disposable gloves.

April 2019: Spontex® has partnered with recycling experts TerraCycle to launch the Spontex® Disposable Gloves Recycling Scheme, a free nationwide recycling solution for vinyl, latex, nitrile and polyethylene disposable gloves in the UK.

The Spontex® Disposable Gloves Recycling Scheme is a new recycling fundraising programme which enables people to recycle any brand of disposable vinyl, latex, nitrile and polyethylene disposable gloves for free whilst raising funds for the school, charity or non-profit of the sender's choice.

Disposable gloves are made from a variety of materials that are difficult to recycle which is why they aren't recyclable through council recycling systems in the UK. Now following the launch of the new Spontex® Disposable Gloves Recycling Scheme, once TerraCycle receives the vinyl, latex, nitrile and polyethylene disposable gloves they will be separated by composition, then sterilized before being cryo-milled into a fine powder and re-purposed to make things like floor tiles, sports fields, tracks and padding etc., reducing the need to create new virgin materials.

Anyone can sign up to the Spontex® Disposable Gloves Recycling Scheme for free at www.terracycle.co.uk/spontex either as a private collector or as a public location. Public drop off locations are visible on a TerraCycle map which enables other people in that area to drop off their disposable gloves for recycling as well. The scheme rewards shipments of over 20 gloves with 2 TerraCycle points (equivalent to £0.02) per glove which can be donated to the school, charity or non-profit of the sender's choice.

Jo Evans, Head of Marketing from Spontex® UK commented: "As a leading European cleaning tools brand, we believe that we can no longer design a great product unless we take into account its environmental footprint and constantly strive to reduce its environmental impact year after year. When we launch disposable products to meet consumer needs, we believe that we must give these products a second life and find them a new purpose. About the Spontex® Disposable Gloves Recycling Scheme

HOW IT WORKS



Participating is completely free and very easy.

This recycling programme is open to all individuals, schools, organisations (charities, town halls, local authorities) and companies based in the UK. If you do not have a TerraCycle® account yet, there are two steps you will need to complete to register for the Spontex® Disposable Gloves Recycling Scheme.

- 1. You must create an account at www.terracycle.co.uk by clicking on the sign-up button and filling out the form.
- 2. Then click "join programme for free" on the Spontex® Disposable Gloves Recycling Scheme page.

Then when the collector wants to post a shipment, they download a free UPS label from their account, attach it to the shipment and then simply order a free pick-up via UPS by calling 03457 877 877 or book a collection online. UPS will then collect from their location. Or the parcels can also be dropped off at the nearest UPS drop-off point.

For each shipment containing over 20 disposable gloves on the Spontex® Disposable Gloves Recycling Scheme, the sender receives 2 TerraCycle® points which is the equivalent of 2 pence per glove. 100 TerraCycle® points represents £1. The points can then be redeemed to the school, charity or non-profit of the sender's choice.

Once TerraCycle receives the vinyl, latex, nitrile and polyethylene disposable gloves they will be separated by composition, then sterilized before being cryo-milled into a fine powder and re-purposed to make things like floor tiles, sports fields, tracks and padding etc., reducing the need to create new virgin materials.
