To participate, shoppers are invited to bring their accepted waste, that is not curbside recyclable, to the designated recycling hubs that are positioned outside the participating Walmart Supercenters and Sam's Club locations. When the hub station is full, TerraCycle will pick up and transport the waste to regional

material recovery facilities where the waste will be sorted by material type and recycled into raw materials that can be used to make new products, like playgrounds and park benches.
